



Upon arrival to Cracow airport meet your local host and transfer to your hotel. En route panoramic guided tour of the city including the Old Town and the Jewish guarter and views and riding by the house where Karol Wojtyla spent the Krakow period of his life until ordination. When the Woitvlas, father and son, moved to Krakow, they set up housekeeping in the tiny basement of a gray two-story house at #10 Tyniecka Street, on the western bank of the Vistula. Karol's maternal uncle, Robert Kaczorowski, a master leather maker who built it after WW, owned the house.



In the footsteps of the Pope John Paul II >>

Pope John Paul II - an extraordinary Pole, the first Polish Pope in the history of the successors of Saint Peter and the first Bishop of Rome in over 450 years who was not from Italy. The Holy Father went on several pilgrimages to Poland, which from the beginning of the eighties underwent radical transformations, as did all of Central and Eastern Europe, During his 7 pilgrimages to his home country, John Paul II almost always visited the capital. In Warsaw there are many places connected with him in special ways. They were witnesses to important words and grand gestures. Kraków and its region are the homeland of Karol Wojtyła, Pope John Paul II. From here he set off to Rome for the Conclave which elected him Pope. He loved to return to these places both in spirit and during his papal visits to his homeland: Here, in this land, I was born. Here, in Kraków, I spent most of my life (...) Here, too, I experienced the grace of the vocation and took the holy orders (...). Here also, in Wawel Cathedral, I was ordained as bishop.

John Paul II Beloved Homeland >>

Day 1: Kraków: Arrival in Kraków – a city which has strong connections with Pope John Paul II and the only city in the world that includes places that cover almost his entire life. Overnight stay in Kraków. Day 1: Kraków: You will be given a professional, guided tour of the city, including a visit to the Bishop's Palace in which the Holy Father Pope John Paul II resided on each of his pilgrimages to Kraków. The programme also includes entry into St. Mary's Church where John Paul II gave sermons and heard confession and a visit to Wawel Cathedral where Bishop Karol Wojtyła went at Christmas to sing carols. We will also show you the Sukiennice Cloth Hall, one of Kraków's most notable sites which is recognizable throughout the world and whose beginnings go back to the 13th Century.

Following in the footsteps of St. Faustina's Vocation >>

Day 1: Warszawa: Arrival in Warszawa. On day one you will be given a have a half-day tour of Warszawa, during which you will see the Old Town, St. John's Cathedral, the Royal Castle from the outside, the elegant Royal Way, Łazienki and the Convent of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, which Helena Kowalska, known as Saint Sister Maria Faustyna Kowalska, entered in 1925. In the afternoon we invite you to attend holy mass. Overnight stay in Warszawa. Day 2: Warszawa - Niepokalanów- Płock - Warszawa (230 km): Today we will take you to Niepokolanów, home of one of the biggest Franciscan monastic complexes devoted to the cult of St. Maximilian Kolbe. It is also a Marian shrine and a destination for many pilgrimages each year. In the afternoon you will travel to Płock, where you will visit the former Benedictine Abbey and the Divine Mercy Shrine in Plock. It was here that Saint Sister Faustyna Kowalska had her first vision of Jesus as King of Divine Mercy. You will visit a museum full of mementoes of Saint Faustyna, such as her nun's cell and a replica of the bakery in which she worked. Overnight stay in Warszawa.

Easter Fair - April 2011

Easter, the oldest Christian festival, is a movable feast, celebrated in the Roman Catholic Church in spring, on the first Sunday after the Paschal Full Moon (earliest 22 March, latest 25 April). This holiday, preceded by the long period of preparation called Lent, is accompanied by many traditions and ceremonies whose beauty arouses wide interest. In Kraków, the material side of proper Easter celebration is looked after by the Merchants' Guild, which organises the annual Easter Fair in the Main Market Square.

Palm Sunday - April 17,2011

The last Sunday before Easter, known as April Sunday, Willow Sunday, or most commonly Palm Sunday, has many ancient and modern traditions associated with it. Following the ancient custom, on this day churches bless the willow branches which have replaced Jerusalem's palm leaves and which are called palms.

Easter - April 22-26, 2011


In the last week of Lent, since 1608 the Paschal Triduum has been celebrated in Kalwaria Zebzrydowska. The events of the Passion are acted out there against a backdrop of a landscape which mirrors the topography of Jerusalem with the participation of crowds of believers whose ranks swell to over 100 thousand. On Good Friday, many churches celebrate the Way of the Cross service (in Miechów, for example, and also for over ten years in the streets of Kraków's Kazimierz district there has been a Way of the Cross celebrated by numerous believers).

Beatification of John Paul II - May 1, 2011

Benedict XVI has agreed to decree the recognizing of a miracle through the intercession of John Paul II. This fact has formally ended the Pope's beatification process. The beatification will be held on May 1 on Sunday of Divine Mercy. In 2000 John Paul II canonized Faustina and announced the first Sunday after Easter to be the Sunday of Divine Mercy.


